







Background:

This vibrant spectrum of contests, carefully curated to align seamlessly with the conference theme of digital health advancements, aims not only to encourage collaboration but also to nurture creativity and explore novel solutions.

Amidst this plethora of initiatives, a poignant competition stands out—dedicated to fostering awareness and understanding of Tuberculosis. This unique contest transcends traditional boundaries, inviting participants to engage in insightful interviews with TB patients.

It serves as a poignant reminder that behind every diagnosis lies a narrative waiting to be heard, beckoning participants to be not just observers but compassionate interpreters of the human condition. In essence, this competition exemplifies our collective commitment to fostering awareness and a profound understanding of Tuberculosis, weaving together threads of empathy and knowledge to create a tapestry reflecting the true essence of public health advocacy.

Competition Details:

Capture the first-hand experiences and insights of TB patients through a 5-minute video interview. Participants are required to conduct an interview with a Tuberculosis (TB) patient (either Pulmonary TB or Multi-Drug Resistant TB) covering various aspects of their journey, from diagnosis to post-treatment. Additionally, submit a written report (500-1000 words, including 1-2 photographs) to accompany the video.

Competition Objective:

Highlighting the human face of tuberculosis and raising awareness about the challenges and triumphs of those affected.

Rules and Regulations

Video Interview Guidelines:

Patient Selection: Choose a TB patient willing to share their story. Ensure consent is obtained for the interview and video recording.

Video Format: Create a 5-minute video interview with a TB patient. Ensure clarity, compassion, and a focus on the competition's themes.





Questions to Include during Interview:

- Knowledge about TB
- Risk factors (e.g., alcohol, smoking)
- Delay in diagnosis and treatment
- Treatment compliance and challenges
- Side effects, if any
- Out-of-pocket expenditure
- Awareness and utilization of national schemes
- Role of these schemes in their health
- Expectations from the NTEP program
- Health condition post-treatment
- Challenges during TB treatment
- Integration with other programs (e.g., NP-NCD, NACO)

Written Report Guidelines:

- Format: Submit a written report (500-1000 words) detailing the key insights from the interview.
- Photographs: Include 1-2 photographs related to the patient's journey, with proper consent.
- Content:
- ✓ **Introduction:** Briefly introduce the patient and their background.
- ✓ Interview Summary: Provide a summary of the key points discussed in the interview.
- ✓ Challenges Faced: Highlight challenges faced during the TB journey.
- ✓ **Impact of National Schemes:** Discuss the patient's perspective on the impact of national schemes and other government health initiatives on their health.
 - Conclusion: Summarize the overall experience and insights gained.

Submission Deadline: The last date for submission is December 31, 2023.


